## **FORMER CABINET MINISTER JONATHAN AITKEN TO UNVEIL MAJOR NEW REPORT ON PRISON REFORM – MONDAY 23 MARCH**

Former Cabinet Minister Jonathan Aitken will unveil a new report calling for an extensive overhaul of the country's prison system on Monday 23 March.

The report *Locked Up Potential* makes over 70 recommendations for action.

The 273-page report has been produced by an 11-strong working group chaired by Mr Aitken.

Joining Mr Aitken at the launch of the report will be the former Conservative Leader and head of the Centre for Social Justice Iain Duncan Smith.
