## **RAY MALLON TO UNVEIL MAJOR NEW REPORT ON POLICE REFORM FOR THE CENTRE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE – MONDAY 30 MARCH**

Elected Mayor of Middlesbrough and former police officer Ray Mallon will unveil a major new report on police reform on Monday 30 March.

At the heart of the report *A Force to be Reckoned With* is the call for police to “reclaim the streets” by ending the “arrest or ignore” culture prevalent in modern policing and suffocating levels of bureaucracy.

The 156-page report has been produced by an 8-strong working group chaired by Mr Mallon and including former chief constables.

Joining Mr Mallon at the launch of the report will be the former Conservative Leader and chairman of the Centre for Social Justice Iain Duncan Smith MP.
